

## PASSPORT AND VISA REQUIREMENTS

### PASSPORT REQUIREMENT

Your passport must be valid for at least 6 months beyond your date of entry into Israel and/or Jordan and you must have a round-trip ticket.

### VISA REQUIREMENTS FOR ISRAEL AND JORDAN

Nationals of the following countries do not need to obtain an entry permit or visa prior to their arrival in Israel; they automatically receive a Tourist Visa, valid for three months, upon entering the country:

If you are a national of a country **not** on this list you must secure a visa in advance of your arrival. The process can take up to several months.

**VISA TO JORDAN:** A group visa, free of charge, is secured for those traveling overland to Jordan from Israel. If you are flying directly into Jordan, you will have to purchase a visa at the airport. However, if you are not a citizen of the U.S., Mexico, a South American or Western European country, you might need to make application for a visa in advance of your arrival at the airport or to cross the overland border from Israel with the group.

**If you are a national who requires that you secure a visa in advance of your arrival for either program**, UHL can only assist you in the process if you are enrolling for academic credit. Both Israel and Jordan may not approve visas for nationals from certain countries.
